AIRCRAFT PREPARATION

Our PBY-6A is in its final stages of preparation for its Ferry Flight. They anticipate the aircraft will be ready for test flying in early November. The Ferry Flight under the leadership of Australia's most experienced pilot, **Jim Hazleton** is scheduled for Nov 15.

Seia, Ajaccio, Naples, Brindisi, Cyprus, Bahrain, Muscat, Karachi, Bombay, Calcutta, Bangkok, Singapore, Dili, Darwin, Cairns, Brisbane, Bankstown.

An Alternate route would be Cairo, Colombo, Medan, Jakarta, Surabaya

The aircraft is expected to arrive in Australia in mid Dec
